All copy should be submitted on a PC or Mac disk if possible. Do not format type for boldface, underlines, etc. Simply type onto disk, with single paragraph returns only after paragraphs. Save as text only. Include file names, software package, and version. When e-mailing, simply paste the article into the body of your message.
